Experience a one-time-only exclusive H-DTHS “Presidential” tour with Society President & National War College professor Paul Thompson, as your personal tour guide of some notable Presidential sites! Our tour begins in the morning with a stop at the Smithsonian Institution, the world’s largest museum complex and research organization composed of 19 museums and 9 research centers, including the National Zoo. Wear your walking shoes to do a self-guided tour of the museums located on the National Mall, and visit the National Archives, the Natural History Museum, or the National Air & Space Museum.

Our next stop is lunch “on your own” (\$11.95 buffet) in the Officer’s Club at the National War College on Fort Lesley J. McNair, the oldest active Army Post in existence today. The War College is a unique institution concerned with “the formulation of national and foreign policy in both peace and war...” for U.S. and international graduates.

Following lunch, our own H-DTHS President and National War College professor Paul Thompson will conduct a personal guided tour of Ft. McNair and the College. Experience national war history and view the site of the trial and subsequent hanging of four co-conspirators associated with President Lincoln’s assassination, the rooms where the D-Day invasion was planned and the containment strategy for the Cold War was developed, and the Colin Powell Collection.

On the journey back to Hershey, enjoy a meal or a cup of coffee on your own at the Cozy Restaurant, in Thurmont, MD. The Cozy is the oldest restaurant in Maryland, and has played host to Presidents, cabinet members, and foreign dignitaries, and is home of the renowned Camp David Museum and Presidential gift shop.
